The thought is good, yet challenging, because at the time they begin to feel the beauty of telling others about The Creator, they do not realize that it is based on much sound reasoning, concern, willingness, interest, and yes, totally believing in the Greatness of The Creator; the important part of understanding what a valuable vocation, leading others morally, spiritually, through the physical, is greater than mankind can comprehend.

Today as I speak, for those present I taught much, alerting the minds of those present to the value of spiritual growth, spiritual knowledge, spiritual values, spiritual participations.
