

## SAINT ATHANASIUS

**I** am Saint Athanasius. In some ways it is sad to see so many so-called various understandings of belief in The Father, The Creator. Many different ages of individuals of all degrees of mentality, oftentimes base their beliefs on what is comfortable for them, not what is sound fact in the subject's full meaning.

**W**e hear some individuals speak of standards of practice on moral values. Not always are these standards based on the same format in which the Commandments were meant to be honored, adhered to, and obeyed.

**I**f you were to ask each one you meet every day, 'Did you break a Commandment of God today?' they would likely be upset, perhaps even angry that you would ask them such a question. But then, there would be some who would say, 'I have not killed anyone today, I have not committed adultery today, so I feel I have not failed in any way.' ***Now ask yourself: Do you examine your conscience, your practices in life, how you associate with others, and how your actions can be imitated in a moral standard according to what the Commandments of God are all about?***

***that through the Soul they are the custodian of, that The Creator of All Things, all human life, knows all things?***
