**T**hese Commandments were profound, and yet entrusted to but one man whom God had prepared, physically, mentally, emotionally, spiritually. This man based his own life on justice, service, love, humility, honesty, sincerity, which gave him the firm foundation to be the recipient, the guardian, and the dispenser of such a Magnificent Commission for all mankind, for all time.
