## “ACTIONS SPEAK LOUDER THAN WORDS”

“**W**hat inward strength drives a person to show a *courageous spirit* in the face of personal combat of physical, emotional, mental or spiritual warfare?”

**F**ear, being a natural instinct, must be considered. Cowardice is never to be ignored. Innate knowledge of a lack of physical strength is never omitted.
