A Bouquet of Love for God in the Way of Saint Therese of Lisieux, 'The Little Flower'



Saint Therese of Lisieux lived in France and died when she was 24 years old. She was known as "The Little Flower" because she offered little sacrifices to God and said they were like little flowers for Him.

She followed the "Little Way" to God with small actions and kind words in her daily life.

"Many men call Me 'The Little Flower'. I smile at this when I hear them say, 'She found the Little Way to God.' It is true, the 'Little Way' was Mine, but for many here now in this room, I suggest this way for you.

Ask yourself: If you walked through a field of flowers, would you knock them down or would you step in places so as to not destroy the flowers?"
